EVENT #1..... BOOK RELAY
LOCATION..... Large baseball diamond
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....5 total; 4 carriers and one fixer

Person standing on home plate with book on head. At the signal runner from Team A proceeds from home to first and runner from Team B proceeds from home to third. At each base fixer removes book and places it on next team member's head.

NOTE: Person dropping book must return to starting base no more than two times before the fixer is allowed to place book back on head at point of droppage.

Designated runner runs from this event and tags participant in event #2 to start that event.

EQUIPMENT.....2 books (preferably heavy)

EVENT #2..... THREE-LEGGED RACE
LOCATION..... Center field of large diamond
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 9 total; 8 relayers and one runner

Four pairs of runners from each team are in position to run the relay. Relay race proceeds until all four two-man teams have run their race. Designated runner runs from this event to the pits to start third event.

EQUIPMENT..... 8 pieces of strong rope; strong legs

EVENT #3..... PIT STOP RELAY
LOCATION..... jumping pits
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....2 totals

Contestants are required to fill a cup with saw dust, using a spoon and making sure that little sawdust is dropped along the course. Upon completion of event one runner will run to the newcombe courts for next event.

EQUIPMENT.....2 soup spoons; two juice cups; one very steady hand

EVENT #4..... NEWCOMBE SPLISH*SPLASH EVENT
LOCATION..... NEWCOMBE COURT
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 8 total; 4 two-man teams

Each two-man team must throw water balloon over newcombe net four times, whereupon they hand balloon to next two-man team and repeat procedure.

NOTE: If balloon breaks (which it will) the two-man team competing at the time must begin with toss number one again.

EQUIPMENT..... Mucho water balloons; willingness to get soaked

EVENT #5.....JAMAICA LIMBO EVENT
LOCATION..... Near the Inter basketball court
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 3 total

Upon being tagged limbo boy or girl jumps over first pole, goes under second pole, and jumps over third pole, turns..... goes under third pole, over second pole, and under first pole. Process is then repeated by other two members.

NOTE.....If a person dislodges a pole, person must repeat entire course.

NOTE #2..... CONFUSED???? Read it over.....

EQUIPMENT..... 12 chairs; 6 poles; slende r bellies....

EVENT #6..... BALLOON POP RELAY
LOCATION..... Tennis practice wall
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Each team member must break one balloon with a maximum of 9 dart throws. Team members proceed one at a time; waiting their turn until prior team member completes requirement.

EQUIPMENT..... 10 balloons; 6 darts

EVENT #7..... CIRCULAR SHUFFLEBOARD
LOCATION..... Inter basketball courts
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Each team member, in turn, will shoot disks at three concentric circles, whose point values will be one, two, and three. Each member will shoot and retrieve until he has achieved a score of three.

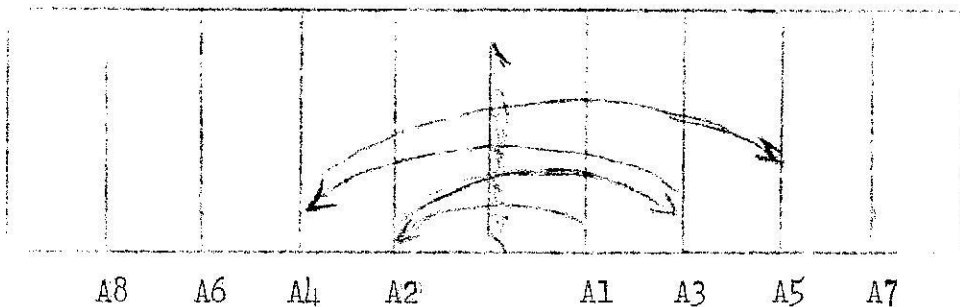
NOTE..... If disk is on line, no points are awarded.

EQUIPMENT..... Shuffleboard disks, sticks; chalk; alot of luck

EVENT #8..... EGG TOSS
LOCATION..... Tennis court closest to pool
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 8 total

Four members from each team are at both sides of the net and designated points. The object is to toss egg back and forth through all eight team members WITHOUT THE EGG BREAKING. (It's raw, you know...)

NOTE..... Please study diagram below.....



A1 throws egg to A2; A2 throws egg to A3.....
Team has five rounds to complete all tosses. A round is not considered "official" unless the egg has reached position number four. After five "bad breaks", the fresh egg starts at the point of droppage.

EQUIPMENT..... plenty of raw eggs; chalk; alot of cleaner-uppers

EVENT #9.....STUFF YOUR FACE RELAY
LOCATION.....Tennis court furthest from the pool
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 3 total

Each member, in turn, will eat a piece of pie... without their hands or the use of any utensils.

EQUIPMENT..... 6 pieces of pie; napkins (?); table; good appetites

EVENT #10.....INSPECTION RELAY
LOCATION.....Freshmen basketball courts
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....4 total; 2 teams of 2

Object is to make bed consisting of 1 sheet and 1 blanket with each team member only allowed to use one hand. Bed must be reasonably neat.

EQUIPMENT..... 2 beds; 2 sheets; 2 blankets; a will to be neat

EVENT #11..... EDELWEISS RELAY
LOCATION..... Freshmen campfire site
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Each team member, in turn, must devour a cracker and then sing the first two lines of the Hill alma mater. THAT'S WHISTLE..... not sing. As in past events, no contestant may begin until prior member has completed requirement.

EQUIPMENT..... crackers; a good whistle

EVENT #12..... DONKEY TAIL RELAY
LOCATION..... BOYS archery targets
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Each team member, after being made thoroughly dizzy, will pin a tail on the target WITHOUT USING THE OTHER HAND FOR CLUES. Each team member goes consecutively until a score of 25 points is gained. Moving from the outer most circle to the bull's-eye, the values are 1,3,5,7,9.

EQUIPMENT..... 8 tails; tape; good eyesight (???)

EVENT #13..... OVER*UNDER RACE
LOCATION..... Near the soccer field
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 8 total

A "shaving cream" pie will be passed over and under consecutively. If the "pie" is dropped, it starts again from the beginning of the line. Event is completed when first member is back in original position.

EQUIPMENT.....shaving cream; soup bowls; a steady passing hand

EVENT #14.....BROOMBALL
LOCATION.....Soccer field
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....5 total

continued...

Upon being tagged from prior event, each member in turn sweeps the ball up field and scores a goal. Next member then goes in opposite direction and event is completed when all members have scored.

EQUIPMENT..... 2 brooms; 2 softballs; skill in soccer (?????)

EVENT #15.....BUBBLE GUM RELAY
LOCATION.....Near canoe docks
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....4 total

Each member, in turn, must start a fresh piece of gum and blow a bubble until the bubble reaches a 2 inch diameter. Event is finished when all members one at a time have completed requirement.

EQUIPMENT..... 8 pieces of gum

EVENT #16..... TAKE IT ALL OFF RELAY
LOCATION..... Shaded area near small baseball diamond
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Each team member puts on pants, shirt, and socks (all buttons and zippers must be fastened) and runs to specified point. Here he takes off all clothing and second member puts on the same. Event is completed when all members have put on and taken off the clothing.

EQUIPMENT..... 2 pants; 2 shirts; 2 pairs of socks; good dressers & strippers

EVENT #17..... WHEELBARROW RACE
LOCATION..... Small baseball diamond
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....8 total; 4 two-man teams

Team A goes from home to third. Team B goes from home to first. The teams complete their required course at second base where the second two-man team continues. Thus the four 2-man teams will travel around the diamond twice.....

EQUIPMENT..... . strong wrists

EVENT #18..... SACK RACE
LOCATION..... Outfield of small baseball diamond
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 4 total

Relay race in which each person runs to designated spot INSIDE a laundry bag.

NOTE....After each person completes the run, the laundry bag is handed over to the next member, who completes his run inside the sack.

EVENT #19.....MIXED SHOE EVENT
LOCATION.....Freshmen kickball field and riflery baseball field
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 10 total

All 10 members of each team are seated on third base line of kickball field. Upon being tagged by a runner from the sackrace, the 10 members will proceed to the riflery range pitcher's mound where they will seek out their shoes, put them on, and return to the third base line. When all 10 members are once again seated,

with their correct shoes on, a designated runner will proceed to the dolphin area of the pool.

NOTE.....Contestants must be wearing any kind of shoe... EXCEPT THONGS
EQUIPMENT.....20 pairs of shoes; speed and quickness; clean feet

EVENT #20.....PPBB Event
LOCATION.....Dolphin area of the pool
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM.....5 total

Each team member blows ping pong ball from one rope to the next, tags next member who then repeats procedure in opposite direction. Event is completed when all 5 members have completed requirement.

EQUIPMENT.....2 ping pong balls; plenty of hot air

EVENT # 21..... THE BIGGIE.....*****
LOCATION..... Deep end of Olympic pool
CONTESTANTS PER TEAM..... 2 boy captains, 2 girl captains

There are two canoes in the deep end of the pool with Connie in one and Herb in the other. The four captains on each team, using the fireman's brigade technique must fill the canoes until they hopefully sink.

THE FIRST TEAM THAT FILLS THE CANOES SO THAT THE WATER LEVEL OF THE POOL AND THE TOP OF THE CANOE ARE THE SAME WINS GOOFY DAY.
