

I. Philosophy

- A. Friendly competition in various scheduled activities intended to bring out the best in athletic attainment, sportmanship, and wholesome character development.
 - B. Within the maturity level of the campers, Red and Blue is a camper project. Campers will organize their own teams and control their own activities.
 - C. Red and Blue begins and ends with each activity or special event listed in this book. There is no Red and Blue in the bunk, in swims, in the Dining Hall or in evening social programs.
- II. Counsellors will serve to stimulate interest, assist campers with difficult problems, restrain over-exuberance, judge events and supervise the conduct of the campers at all times.
 - III. Counsellors may not exhibit any outward signs of partiality toward either team by word, manner or dress.
 - IV. All Red and Blue activities must be carried on between reveille and curfew,-- camper curfew for camper activities, counsellor curfew for related counsellor activities. This includes song writing and the making of banners.
 - V. Group Leaders will designate each morning the counsellors assigned to supervise songfest rehearsals that day.
 - VI. Group Leaders will select counsellors, to officiate and others to supervise. each team for each game scheduled during Red and Blue.
 - VII. Where an event requires a line-up or an entry, the team leaders must present it on paper before the event to the respective Group Leader.
 - VIII. If a tie exists upon the completion of a total event, the bonus points that would have been awarded to winner and loser will be totalled and divided evenly between the two teams. If the resulting number is not a multiple of 5, the teams will each be given a number equal to the next higher multiple of 5.
 - IX. Judges' decisions are final. The only possible appeal from a judges's decision is on a point of rules. Such appeal is to be made to the Head Counsellor. His action will be final.
 - X. Let's work together to make Red and Blue a spirited, enjoyable, and emotionally wholesome event.

THE LAW OF THE FEST

I. SONGS

BOYS

- A. Team or Fight Song
- B. Alma Mater
- C. Friendship Song

GIRLS

- A. Team or Fighting Song
- B. Alma Mater
- C. Cheer
- D. Friendship Song (optional-
no points.)

II. SCORING

- A. Presentation - 50 points
 - 1. Quality of singing or cheering
 - 2. Participation of campers
 - 3. Enthusiasm and spirit
- B. Originality - 25 points
Originality and appropriateness of words, sentiments, thoughts.
- C. Suitability - 25 points
 - 1. Usable in camp
 - 2. Catchy
 - 3. Possibility of lasting in future years
(Simplicity, ease of learning, appeal)
- D. Method of Computing Score
 - 1. Each song or cheer is rated upon the basis of 100 as the perfect score.
 - 2. The breakdown into categories is only as a general guide for judges to keep in mind. They will record only the total mark for each song.

III. RULES

- A. Only rehearsals listed in this book are permitted. Additional rehearsals may be scheduled only by mutual agreement of the counselor captains of both teams.
- B. Songs and cheers must be submitted to the office before rehearsals begin.
- C. The songfest will be conducted in Saniford Hall.
- D. No decorations, costumes, or additions of any kind to camp uniforms are permitted. Teams will be dressed as follows:
 - 1. Boys Red Team - Red or white T-shirt, blue or khaki shorts
 - 2. Boys Blue Team - Blue Saginaw T shirt, blue or khaki shorts
 - 3. Girls Red Team - Red Saginaw blouse, white shorts
 - 4. Girls Blue Team - Blue blouse, white shorts
 - 5. Counsellor captains - No restrictions of dress or costume.
